## FROM PLOT TO PLATE

At PLANT, we go to great lengths to reduce the impact that we have on the planet we inhabit. One way we do this is by growing some of the produce that we serve in our food and drink.

By growing our own food, we're not only able to ensure that they're free from pesticides and other nasties that damage the environment, but they also massively reduce our carbon footprint. Instead of travelling hundreds or thousands of miles to get to us, it's a quick 10-minute car journey. This means our food tastes better, is better for our customers, and is better for the environment.

We also have a composting bin at the plot, where we send the fruit and veg scraps from the kitchen, as well as the used loose-leaf tea and coffee grounds we serve in the cafe. This breaks down and turns into nutrient-rich soil in which we grow the produce that ends up back on our customer's plates. Our food goes full-circle, and it's without a doubt the most sustainable way to operate.

As well as our own produce, we try to support local businesses where possible. We put lots of time and energy into sourcing products that have a lesser impact on the planet, and we love that it goes hand-in-hand with being able to support UK-based small businesses!

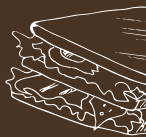
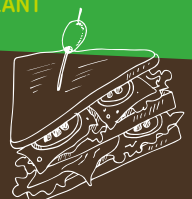

## A TASTE OF THAILAND

### Finale Thai

Recreate Finale Thai's Gluay Bad Chee recipe at home!

Ingredients:

- Two or three bananas
- Coconut milk
- White sugar and salt

Method

1. Heat the saucepan on low. Pour the coconut milk in so it fills less than half of the pan.
2. While the coconut milk starts to bubble, slowly put sugar in the pan starting with 1 1/2 tablespoons followed by a pinch of salt
3. Stir to make sure the sugar and salt combine with coconut milk. Taste it and if you want more sweetness then add more sugar.
4. Slice your banana into inch thick chunks, put in the saucepan and bring to the boil.
5. Boil for about 1 minute and 15 seconds.



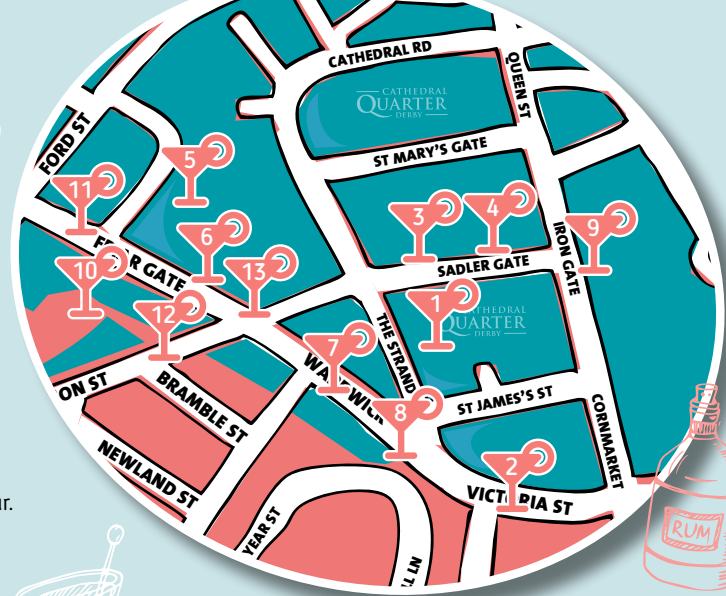

## POD BREW GUIDE: NESPRESSO MARTINI

Already musing those martinis on a Monday evening? We've been there. Impress your mates and create your own Espresso Martinis from the comfort of your own kitchen! Simply follow this step-by-step guide and you'll be slinging martinis like a pro in no time.

### YOU WILL NEED

- BEAR coffee pods
- A Nespresso compatible pod machine
- A glass
- A cocktail shaker
- Strainer and fine strainer
- 40ml Coffee liqueur (we use Mr Black Cold Brew liqueur)
- 20ml Vodka (we use Absolut Original)
- 15ml Sugar syrup (equal parts hot water to sugar, stir until dissolved)
- Ice cubes
- Optional: Coffee beans to garnish

### HOW TO MAKE

1. Firstly choose your favourite BEAR coffee pod.
2. Pop a pod into your machine and extract your shot. Use two pods if you fancy super punchy flavours and an extra pick-me-up.
3. Add your coffee liqueur, vodka, and sugar syrup into your shaker. Once extracted, pour in your shot(s) too.
4. Add cubed ice to your shaker. Be careful to not overfill with ice as this will cause your shaker to pop open! 4-5 standard sized cubes should suffice.
5. Seal your shaker, find your rhythm and get shaking! Around 15-20 seconds at a good pace should be enough!
6. Unseal your shaker and strain immediately into your glass.
7. Garnish your creation with three coffee beans in a centred triangle. Or get drinking straight away.

Side note: We recommend adding 15ml of sugar syrup to your martini to create an even balance of flavours. Feel free to add more or less syrup to cater to your personal taste!

# SARAH'S FONDUE RECIPE

My inspiration for Fondue comes from the home of melted cheese – Switzerland! I fell in love with this beautiful country when I worked there during my younger years. My passion has continued, I visit Montreux every December where I spend 3 days eating my way through mountains of cheese, breads and charcuterie – the highlight every year is visiting the village of Gruyere and indulging in a traditional fondue with a panoramic view of the snow-capped mountains!

- 400g grated Gruyere
- 150g reblochon (rind removed)
- 150g Emmental Grated nutmeg
- 350ml dry white wine
- 4 tsp cornflour
- 2 tbsp Kirsch
- 2 garlic cloves



1. Slice one garlic clove in half and rub the inside of the pan or fondue pot, grate the other clove and leave in the pan.
2. On a low heat melt together the cheeses and cornflour – at this melting point (don't let it boil) add the wine slowly and the grated nutmeg.
3. This should now be smelling tremendous but right at the end add the Kirsch for that true Swiss element!
4. Serve with crusty bread (sourdough is the best as it is firm enough to hold the cheese!) Bresaola, salamis and little cornichons!
