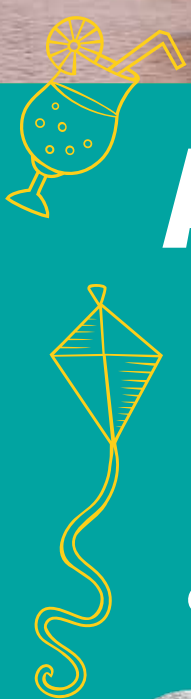

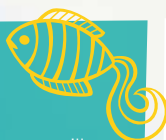

HAKE IN A HURRY

Ingredients

- 4 x 170g skinless and boneless hake fillets
- 2 tbsp vegetable oil
- 80g homemade breadcrumbs
- Handful fresh parsley, finely chopped, plus a few sprigs to garnish
- Salt and pepper
- Lemon wedges, to serve



Method

Pre-heat the oven to 180°C/fan 160°C/gas mark 4.

Wash and dry the hake fillets. Pour the oil into a large baking tray. Place the hake fillets in the tray and gently turn them over and around in the oil to cover them. Season with salt and pepper.

Combine the breadcrumbs with the chopped parsley. Sprinkle the breadcrumbs over the top of the fish fillets. Bake in a oven for 15 – 20 minutes, or until the crumbs are golden and crispy, and the fish cooked through. Serve immediately with lemon wedges, garnished with parsley sprigs.

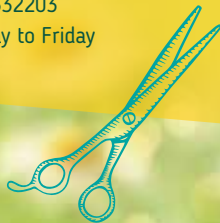

Swap Shop was created purposefully to help small businesses and charities during the first lockdown as a way to support them to survive whilst continuing to build their organisations. As many firms still continue to face challenges today, due to inflation and subsequent cost of living rises, Swap Shop continues to help offset some costs for businesses by facilitating these swaps. 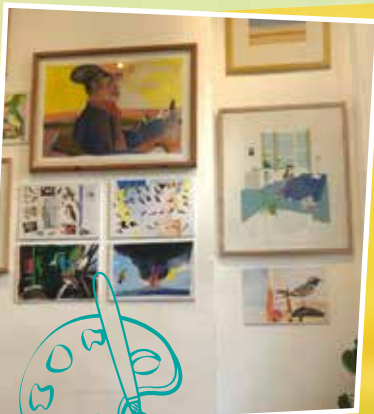
Emotive Art at The Love & Starfish Gallery

THE ART & POETRY PROJECT



The Cathedral Quarter BID have partnered with St Peters Quarter BID and Derby City Council to bring the Art and Poetry project to the city centre over the summer.

Both BIDs were awarded monies from the Additional Restrictions Grant (ARG) Vibrancy Fund which had to be used to support businesses through improved experience and increased footfall whilst creating a more interesting and vibrant environment for visitors to the area.

Working with local artists and The Poetry Project, we have installed a number of artworks across the city alongside empowering and motivational poetry in business windows to create one cohesive art and poetry trail for the public to enjoy.



All the poems have been composed by poet James McInerney, the driving force behind The Poetry Project, an initiative that promotes the healing power of words in public areas. At the same time, artwork designed by Midlands-based artists has been added to windows of six unoccupied units in the city. Artists involved are Lynne Hollingsworth, Carla Dee and artists from Derby based charity Artcore; Theodora Prassa, Joseph Winsborrow, Sofia Yala, and Craig Proud. Two of the windows also incorporate projections provided by QUAD which bring the artwork to life.
